Dynasty Garners Three Medals at Decanter World Wine Awards 2013 The Only Winning Sparkling Wine from China at the World's Largest Wine Competition

(Hong Kong, 22 May 2013) – Dynasty Fine Wines Group Limited (“Dynasty” or the “Group”) (Stock Code: 828), a premier winemaker in China, announced that its three grape wines have been awarded two Bronze and one Commended medals at the Decanter World Wine Awards 2013 (DWWA).

Dynasty’s two dry red wines, “Merlot ‘Jue’ Noble Cask Collection – Imperial” and “Premier Royal Selection – Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve 2008”, both won Bronze medals. “Dynasty Muscat Sparkling Wine” garnered a Commended medal, the only sparkling wine from China to be honoured.

Organised by a leading global wine magazine, *Decanter*, the DWWA is the largest of its kind around the globe. The competition is renowned for its rigorous judging process. This year, the judging panel comprised 219 wine experts from 27 countries, including 75 Masters of Wine and 13 Master Sommeliers. Celebrating its 10th anniversary, this year’s event attracted a record-setting 14,362 grape wines from 52 countries, thus the competition was highly intensive.

Mr Bai Zhisheng, Chairman of Dynasty, said, “Last year, the Group was the most-honoured Chinese winery at the Decanter Asia Wine Awards (DAWA) with four of our wines earning accolades. We are thrilled that our brand goes beyond Asia and shines brightly at this prestigious world-class grape wine competition. All participating grape wines were tasted and judged by top experts in the world. Thus, winning the awards truly represents recognition of the high quality of Dynasty’s wines. We will continue to excel through quality and to providing the best Chinese grape wines to wine lovers around the world.”

Premium Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon vines with a minimum age of 12 years produced in the Helan Mountain regions in Ningxia. It is noble and full-body, with outstanding quality and is silky smooth in texture. It has a rich fruity aroma of matured fruits. Recommended for meat and mature cheeses.

**Dynasty Premier Royal Selection –
Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve 2008**

Harvested from the ripest Cabernet Sauvignon grapes and aged in oak barrels for at least one year. A dry wine with some minerality, it shows balanced acidity for a medium to full body middle palate, good fruit intensity and light touches of spices and wood tannins. Best matched with cold cuts, matured cheeses and pasta dishes.

**Dynasty Muscat
Sparkling Wine**

Harvested from one of the Hangu vineyards in Tianjin. Characteristics are pale lemon and crystal clear with a scent of honey, lime and lychee. The acidity is gentle, balanced by the medium sweet character of this highly aromatic wine. A perfect complement to light desserts.
